40 Assets - Listening to Your Children

Often when small children want to speak to us, we dismiss their concerns as trivial and continue with whatever we are doing, but to them it's a big deal. Cell phones add to this problem: 36% of 11-18 year-olds said they asked their parents to put down their cell phones; of those, 46% said parents took no notice, 44% felt ignored. 90% of parents believed their phone use was not a problem for the children.
