Tip – Asset #32 – Planning & Decision-making

Summer day trips, or longer adventures, provide great opportunities for you to help your children hone their planning & decision-making skills. Have them use paper & pencil to *write* details for the trip, what to take, how to find each item, how much time it will take to assemble, when to start assembling items, who will do each task, etc. Although you may have to give hints along the way, try to ask questions that stretch their thinking, not just answers that fill in the blanks for them. Allowing our children to have significant roles in planning will be educational & fun for all.
