



Dear Friends of IFM,

Last year, Alan and Jo Haight of Riverhill Farm reached out to the Nevada County community for support in growing produce for the clients of Interfaith Food Ministry - the response was amazing!

By the end of the year, IFM was able to use the donations to purchase over \$10,000 in produce at wholesale prices from Riverhill. This meant that over 3,4000 pounds of tomatoes and nearly 900 heads of lettuce (plus many other kinds of vegetables) went to families who might not otherwise have access to the quality produce so many of us take for granted. The appreciation from our clients was overwhelming.

The challenge is that the need remains and is even growing. The average Nevada County family income of a client of IFM is \$1,091 monthly; approximately \$13,092 annually. In 2017, IFM served nearly 7,800 individuals, including over 1,800 children.



Because the need remains, the new Riverhill Farm owners, Daylin and Antonio want to continue to be part of the solution. You can help to make a difference:
