


CONSTRUCTION BOOTCAMP

Construction Fundamentals

3 Classes, 9 Weeks to Completion

Jump start a career in the building trades with the three classes in the Construction Bootcamp at the Sierra College - Nevada County Campus. In just nine weeks, students will learn about the building industry and its various trades, occupational safety, proper and safe hand and power tool operation, as well as material handling and construction techniques. Upon completion, students will be eligible to attend a meet and greet with construction industry professionals to network and explore career opportunities.

Provides an introduction to safety and health hazards that workers may encounter on construction sites, including employee and employer rights and responsibilities. Upon successful completion, 10-hour OSHA card issued by instructor. (pass/no pass grading) (noncredit)

CET 0806 Introduction to Building Trades & Tools

1/31-2/22, Friday & Saturday ONLY, 9-5pm *Prerequisite:* Completion of CET 0805 with grade of "Pass"

Provides an overview of the local/regional building trade industry. Introduces students to the proper and safe operation of hand and power tools used in construction. (pass/no pass grading) (noncredit)

CET 0807 Basic Material Handling & Building

2/28-3/21, Friday & Saturday ONLY, 9-3:50pm *Prerequisite*: Completion of CET 0806 with grade of "Pass"

Provides an overview of building materials, construction techniques, and related building codes. Introduces students to basic trades including plumbing, electrical, and HVAC. (pass/no pass grading) (noncredit)
