- Provides a service beyond school districts and IEP
- · Works with families and school districts to see that students needs are met

Amee Medeiros, ED - Neighborhood Center for the Arts

- Case management/ Outreach and enhanced referrals
- Need to be in the regional center to offer services 22 and older
- Offer services for artists who are "disabled" prefer the term able Artists as that's how community views these talented artists
 - Allows artist to have a separate income
- Had issues with funding and limited care that they can provide at this point

- A day programs hurting for funding and not being able to supply previously provided services
 - Needs legislative advocacy

Michael Lyman, President/CEO - Ridgeline Pediatric Day Health & Respite Services

- Overnight Nursing staff and care for clients
- Provide care for all ages with specialized medical needs and providing skilled nursing need
 - Issues
 - Not able to get to programs in time age out at 22 ages but available to stay is established before 22 yrs. of age
 - Specialized healthcare needs
 - Specialized behavior and specialized healthcare needs
 - Handful of people not being helped because they have age out "adult day health center" like ridgeline pediatrics but for adults
 - Issues with transportation with disability needs
