Presenters:

- Nevada County Children's Behavioral Health Cindy Morgan
 - Serve about 500 children per year-250
 - Medi-cal or specialty mental health to qualify
 - Must have parent/guardians consent
 - Increase in requests since covid, Schools are adding in more services
 - Eating disorder task force, clinician shortage- higher demand
 - Adding in another clinician in July 2023-child and youth wellness coaches in schools
 - Gaps- behavioral analysis-service providers for children's services
- Mental Health in the Schools Emily Gallup
 - Trends Anxiety and depression, more stress and tension also an increase in people asking for help, more school absence, kids who were struggling in school are struggling even more now, lack of standardization at most schools, students with higher needs are stuck in a hard place with no medi-cal,
 - Biggest gap is counselor and therapist shortages, school based counselors are needed for more than just moderate-severe and needed for the children who are just starting to show symptomsmore school based counselors are needed.
- NAMI Lael Walz
 - Mental illness is a brain disorder-Trauma is not typically the cause, support/education programs for the person struggling and families.
 - Biggest challenge is the increase in aggressive mental illness and emergency situations, the biggest gap understanding the medical reasoning in mental illness.
